Mixed Use Development – Project Overview of the Plaza Saltillo Area

Nicola will be providing an overview of recent projects including the recently approved 11 acre tract for the Plaza Saltillo mixed use development between 4th and 5th Street in East Austin. The Plaza Saltillo Area served as Austin's train depot for 100 years until it was abandoned in the 1980s. Capital Metro purchased the property in 1995 with plans to incorporate it into future light rail service. The Capital Metro Board selected Endeavor Real Estate and Columbus Realty to redevelop the 10 acre space. The project will have approximately 800 residential units including senior housing, over 100,000-square-feet of retail, and over 100,000-square-feet of office along the I-35 frontage road. There will be a 1.7-acre park and 1.8 acres of private open space.
