INTRODUCTION

The following tables were prepared to present a concise summary of information relative to International Bridges and Border Crossings. This information was compiled as an aid to analyzing proposals for new or expanded facilities.

The sources of this information are listed on the last page of the document. As noted on the last page the information was compiled from a literature search, personal knowledge of Transportation Planning Division and District personnel and news media records.

For purposes of simplicity and ease of reference the information has been organized on a series of tables as follows:

1. Table I pertains to existing border crossings. Information included identifies: location, ownership, free or toll operation, age, proposed improvements, traffic counts and available GSA funding for customs facilities. Each facility is numerically referenced to accompanying maps.
2. Table II presents available data relative to additional crossings that have been proposed. These bridges are alphabetically referenced to the same maps.
3. The traffic volumes indicated on Table III are from one day (weekday) counts. They have not been adjusted for seasonal or weekend variation. This data does, however, provide a reasonable indication of actual and relative useage.

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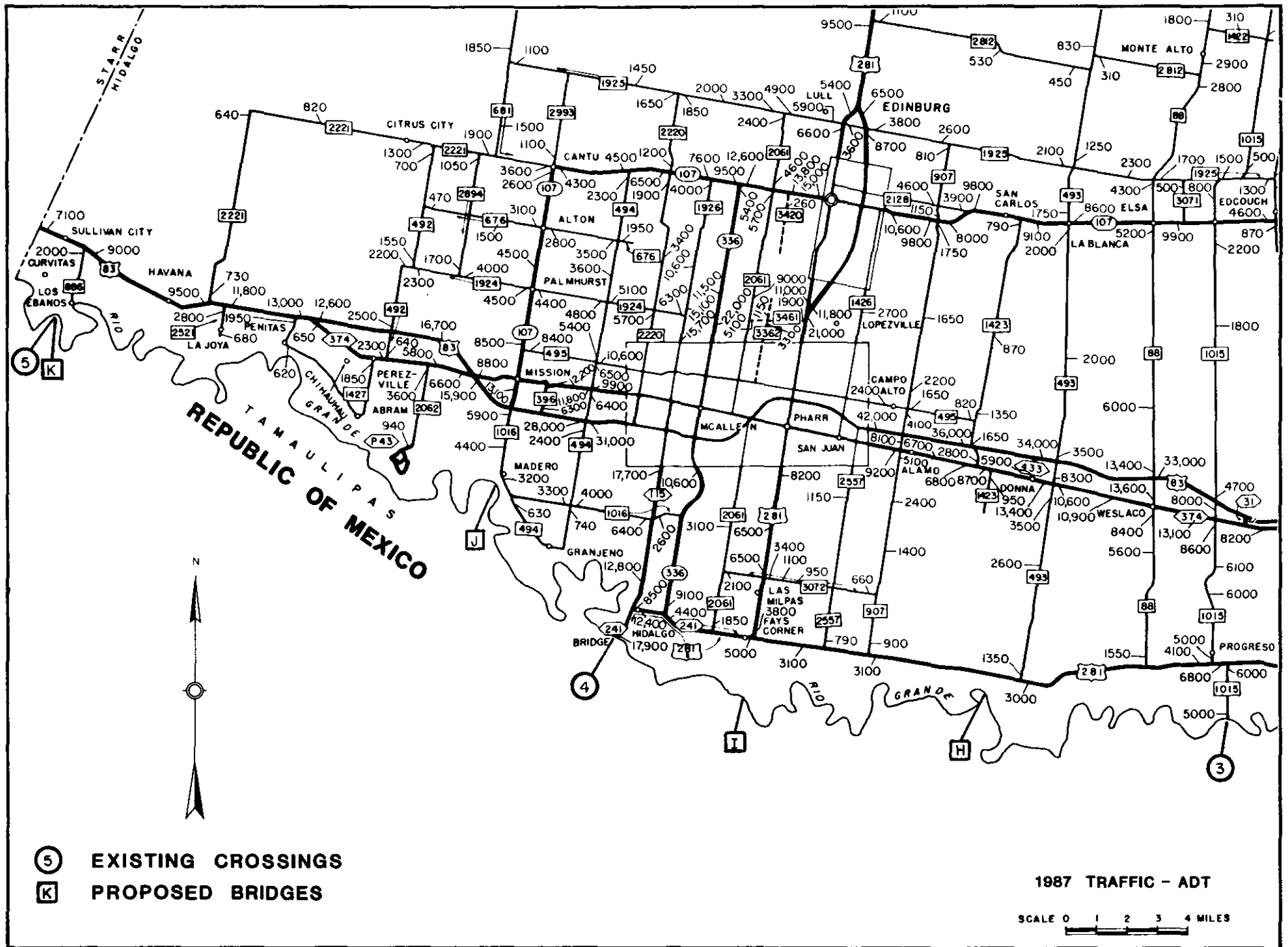

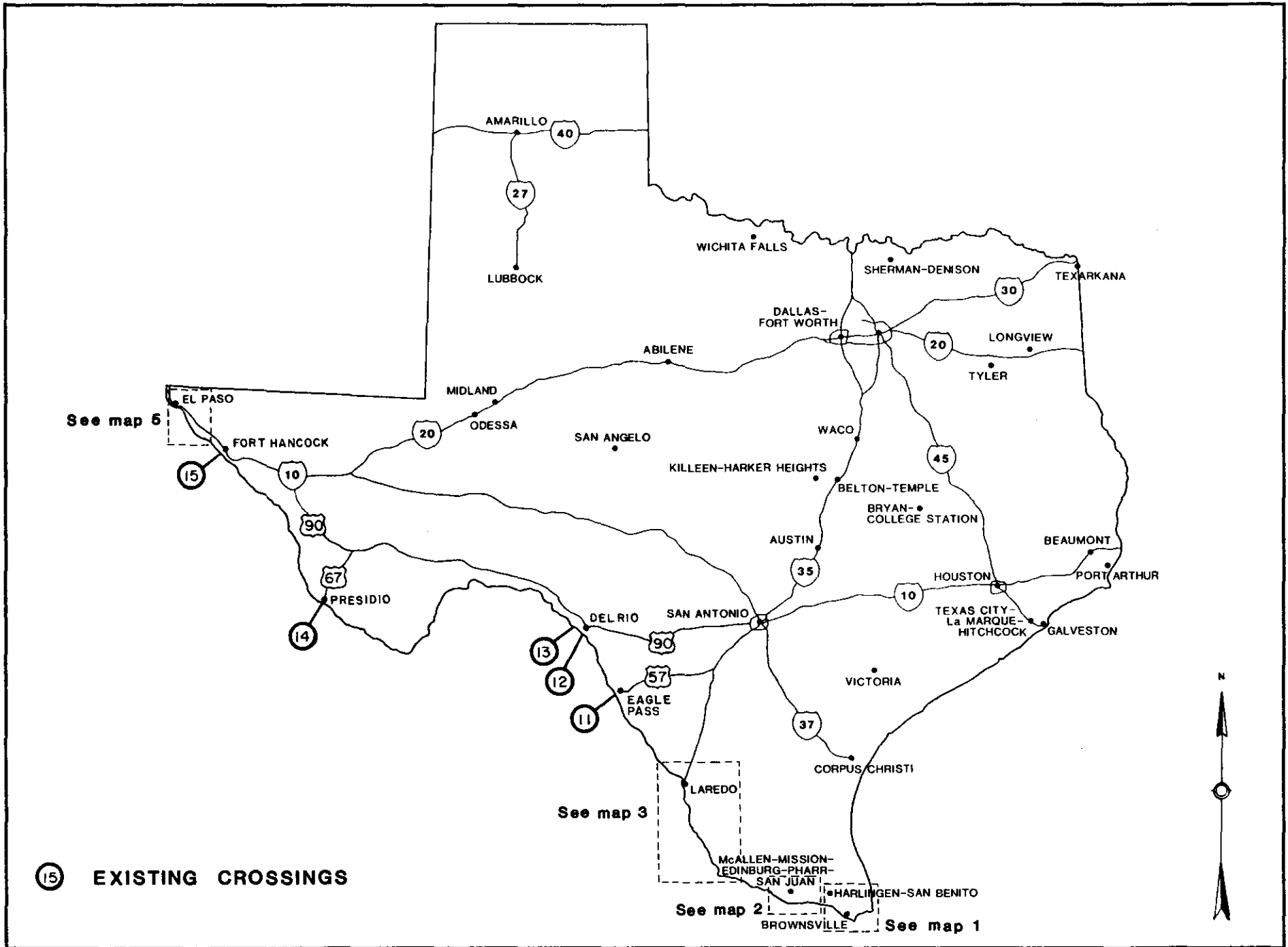

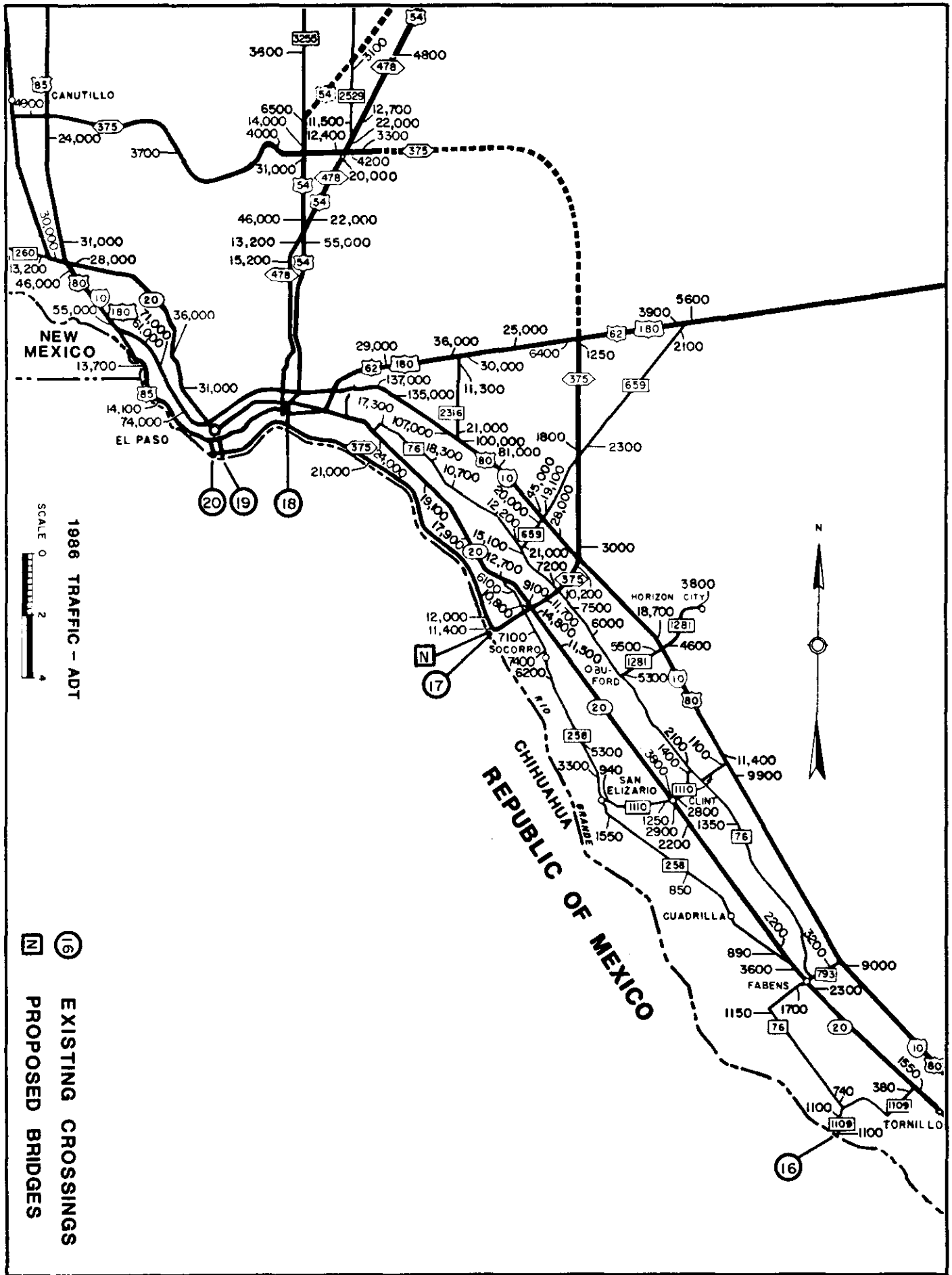
